n this Twenty-Second Sunday of Ordinary Time, Jesus calls us to be an active reflection of Holy Spirit's loving grace of goodness and kindness, wisdom and patience, understanding and mercy in our outward actions. Grace is already within us. Our active living and service must overflow in our good word and deeds of love, obeying and honoring God with praise and thankfulness from our hearts.

First Reading (Deuteronomy 4:1-2,6-8) ~ Moses urges the people to be diligent and faithful in giving heed to the commands of the Lord, indicating their fidelity to the covenant relationship God has made with them.

Second Reading (James 1:17-18,21-22,27) ~ The needs of the abandoned and isolated people are of special and crucial concern in God's law. It is important for all disciples of the Lord to hear and be 'doers' of the word of God in humility and justice, mercy and faith, and not be merely 'hearers', who deceive themselves.

Gospel (Mark 7:1-8,14-15,21-23) ~ Jesus rebukes the Pharisees and scribes in their hypocrisy and neglect of the weightier matters of God's law. Obedience to God's law must be deeper than just observance. Rather than arrogantly looking for reason to judge and criticize others. He challenges them to examine their own inner intentions, and delve deeper into the truth of God's Word, written and spoken by the Prophets, and to live and be active disciples in fulfilling the truth and spirit of God's law.



This Monday, Sept. 2nd, in this part of the world, many of us will pause to celebrate Labor Day. May we profit by reflecting on how our laboring is a blessing for us and for those around us. By our commissioning after each Eucharist, may we answer our baptismal call, never ceasing to labor, minister, serve, and nurture the reign of God

within and beyond the four walls of our church.

Something to Pray About & Ponder ~ If we attend Mass on Sundays, hear and listen to the Scripture readings, receive Communion, and then continue on our merry normal way during the week, choosing to be unchanged in our actions of service, are we truly disciples of Jesus? Are we just paying 'lip service' to the law, without responsibly and sincerely loving God and our neighbor?

There is nothing wrong with following rules and laws. They are necessary. We do, however, need to discern the spirit of laws, and examine and evaluate our priorities and motivations in following them. Do we interpret and follow the letter of the law, and ignore the 'good of the people'? Why do we come to Mass? To attend... or to fully, consciously and actively participate? Do we follow our liturgical practices out of fear or obligation...to avoid punishment? Are we inspired and motivated to better love God and each other by our compassionate service? Only we can answer these questions, knowing the inner-intentions of our own hearts and minds and in our relationship with God. God's Word reveals God's law of Love. We have some prayer, discernment and choices to make, perhaps healthier more loving choices, and to put them into active practice...

Sometimes, conscious and humble prayer can simply be:

- + Thank you, O Lord. Thank you, my God. I thank you.
- + Alleluia! Alleluia!
- + Praise to you, O Lord God.
- + I'm sorry, Lord. Have mercy on me.
